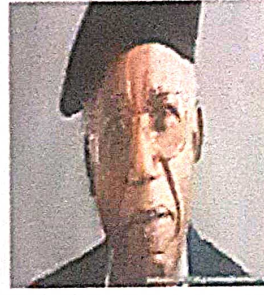
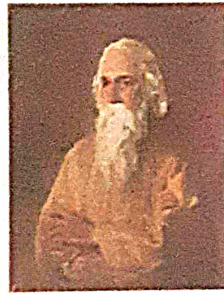

The perception levels of the students will improve.

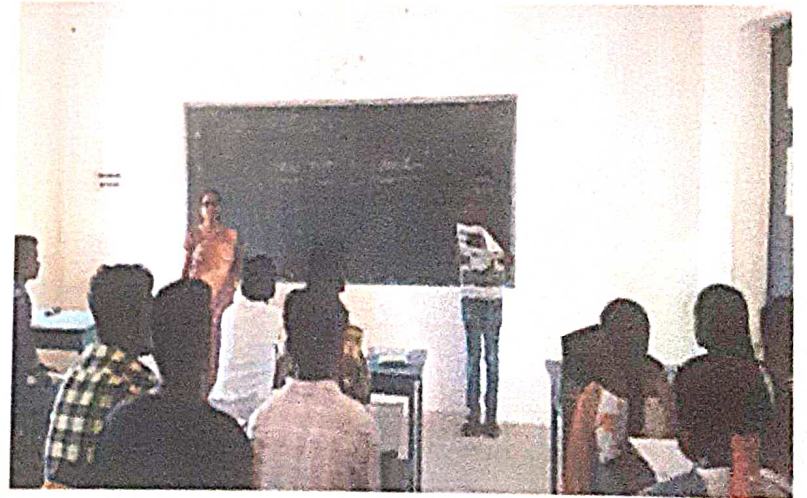
